**ORDER**


On February 3, 2023, the Court sentenced Mr. Hutchinson to 46 months of imprisonment, due to his pleading guilty to violating 18 U.S.C. § 371 and 26 U.S.C. § 7206(1) (Dkt. Nos. 27, 28). The Court ordered Mr. Hutchinson to surrender for service of his sentence at the institution designated by the Bureau of Prisons (“BOP”) before 2:00 p.m. on March 6, 2023. Mr. Hutchinson states that he has not received a designation from the BOP and requests that this Court extend his time to report for an additional three weeks to give the BOP sufficient time to designate a prison to which he should report. Mr. Hutchinson also states that he will report to prison within three days of receiving a designation.

The government represents that the BOP will not designate Mr. Hutchinson until he has been sentenced in the Western District of Missouri on charges pending there but that Mr. Hutchinson may report to the United States Marshals Service office to be held in a contract facility pending his designation by the BOP. Mr. Hutchinson raises additional issues, based on this information shared by the government.

For good cause shown, the Court grants, in part, and denies, in part, Mr. Hutchinson’s request to extend time to report to prison. To the extent Mr. Hutchinson seeks a report date after March 27, 2023, the Court denies without prejudice the request. The Court grants Mr. Hutchinson’s request that he not be required to report until he receives a designation to a BOP

facility, directs that all counsel notify the Court when Mr. Hutchinson receives a designation to a BOP facility, and orders Mr. Hutchinson to surrender for service of his sentence at the institution designated by the BOP before 2:00 p.m. within three days of receiving a designation. If either Mr. Hutchinson or the government seek a further modification of this Order, they may file a written motion making such request. All conditions of Mr. Hutchinson's release shall remain in full force and effect and apply to Mr. Hutchinson pending his report date to the BOP.
